WELCOME

Alison Connelly-Flores, Technical Advisory Committee Chair, welcomed TAC members to the meeting.

Motion: A motion was moved and seconded to approve the minutes from the Technical Advisory Committee's March 19th, 2025, meeting. The Committee unanimously approved the motion.

Alison shared that the NYeC Board approved Matt Doyle, Interoperability Software Development Lead at Epic, to fill the TAC patient privacy seat at its April 1, 2025, meeting.

I. ADT Implementation Guide Update

After receiving the recommendation to create technical implementation guides for some of the technical projects in development, Rob Horst provided the committee with an overview of an ADT Implementation Guide that is starting to get built out.

II. Statewide Patient Record Lookup (sPRL) Replacement

David Horrocks provided an overview of the sPRL, the way that the QEs communicate with each other. The technology is about a decade old, and the committee discussed the architecture to update it.

David discussed strategy acceleration and the letter from Anne Schettine at the Department directing NYeC to accelerate SHIN-NY efficiencies in the short term and the need to work quickly to take steps to prepare for potential funding cuts.

Rob provided the committee with important context and background on Cross QE Alerts and the sPRL Gateway including the current architecture and challenges for each. The new Encounter Gateway project underway was shared with solutions to current



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challenges. The sPRL current state and replacement gateway plans were shared for committee feedback and questions.

III. General Updates

eMOLST

Alex Fitz shared that NYeC was approached to consider adopting the New York State eMOLST registry into its portfolio from Excellus to maintain from a technical perspective. NYeC is in the midst of determining technical options and will be sharing these and asking for input from the TAC in subsequent meetings.

QE Workplan and Funding Agreement

Lindsey Ferris discussed the subset of data elements defined in the Data Quality Framework for committee feedback and discussion.

IV. SCP Update

Brittany Harabedian provided the committee with an update on the Statewide Common Participation Agreement that was approved by the Department. Updates on the Statewide Data Use and Policy committees were shared as well as dates for the next meetings.

The meeting was adjourned. The next Technical Advisory Committee meeting is scheduled for June 16th, 2025.
