WELCOME

Laura Alfredo served as Acting Chair in the absence of SDUC Chair Paul Uhrig and called the meeting to order. Quorum was confirmed.

Motion: A motion was moved and seconded to approve the minutes from the Statewide Data Use Committee's March 5, 2026, meeting. The Committee unanimously approved the motion.

I. Audit & Appeals Governance Clarification

Alison Bianchi clarified that audit and appeals activities conducted by KPMG will be overseen by the NYeC Audit & Compliance Committee rather than SDUC. This ensures independence, as SDUC and NYeC may be subject to audit or appeal outcomes. A future SCPA amendment will correct this language.

II. Use Case Approval – Drug Overdose Surveillance (DOSE)

The Committee reviewed a use case to enhance overdose surveillance using SDI data to supplement mortality data and improve timeliness, completeness, and analysis capability.

Motion: A motion was moved and seconded to approve the Drug Overdose Surveillance use case. The Committee unanimously approved the motion.



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III. Use Case Approval – Birth Defects Registry

The Committee reviewed a use case to support chromosomal anomaly surveillance by improving access to laboratory data through SDI.

Motion: A motion was moved and seconded to approve Birth Defects Registry use case. The Committee unanimously approved the motion.

IV. Use Case Update – Parkinson's Disease Surveillance

NYeC provided an update on an approved use case supporting disease prevalence reporting. Implementation enhancements include adding SNOMED codes to improve cohort capture.

V. SDI / PDR SOP Updates

NYeC presented updates to support expansion of SDI and introduction of the PDR, including a new permitted purpose and a new SOP governing access and use.

Motion: A motion was moved and seconded to approve amendments to the SDI Data Use Approval SOP and the new PDR Data Access and Use SOP. The Committee unanimously approved the motion.

VI. General Updates

Alison Bianchi shared that NYeC is developing an AI governance framework and will provide further updates.

Alexandra Fitz noted that policy development for research use of SDI data is underway.

Alison also provided an update on planned SCPA amendments, with stakeholder engagement underway and implementation targeted for early 2027.

VII. Closing & Next Meeting

The meeting was adjourned. The next Statewide Data Use Committee meeting will be scheduled for August 2026.
